Play your part by operating your RPA safely and responsibly

## DOs

1 Inspect your RPA before each flight and fly it safely.

2 Fly/Operate your RPA or toy aircraft in a safe manner, at all times.

3 Remotely Piloted Aircraft or toy aircraft should remain within the visual line of sight at all times.

4 Fly/ Operate RPA in daylight and clear weather conditions.

For RPA commercial use please obtain your RPAS license from the South African Civil Aviation Authority

## DON'Ts

1 No flying

- within a radius of 10km from an aerodrome.
- above 400ft above the surface.

3 No Flying over or adjacent to a public road.

4 No flying within 50 meters of a building.

5 No Flying

- over people
- within a lateral distance of 50m from any person.

6 No flying near of over a

- national key point
- prison
- police station
- crime scene
- court of law.

7 No dropping of any objects from a drone

2 No Flying in Controlled Airspace.

**DANGERS OF NEGLIGENT OPERATION:**

- Collision with other aircraft, with possible fatal results
- Injury to the public
- Damage to people's property
